Information on your organization's activities help inform the International Secretariat what activities you consider important. All responses will be gathered and reviewed by the Credential, Nominations and Statutes Committee and to International Secretariat Staff to determine dues calculations and voting representation and to strengthen services and support which Members find valuable.

For your information, our programs fall into four categories:

- 1) **ACTION OBJECTIVES** are well-developed programs to which significant human and financial resources are devoted.
- 2) **SMALL SCALE ACTION OBJECTIVES** require a lower level of human and financial resources, but are issues on which WFM-IGP still takes a leadership role in coordinating the larger NGO community's involvement and activities when the necessary funding is successfully secured.
- 3) **POSITION OBJECTIVES** are issues on which WFM-IGP has a well-defined public position and supports other coalitions on the issue as opportunities arise, but does not itself take a leadership role.
- 4) **RESEARCH OBJECTIVES** are projects on which the Movement does not yet have an established position or clear objective to achieve.
