

The Council of the WFM, meeting in BA on 5-8 October, 2010

Aware that new challenges are rising to the top of the world political agenda; mindful of the necessity of integrating the emerging regions of the world to its activities in order to revitalize its founding goals: democratic regional and world federalism; therefore be it resolved that WFM:

- proclaims the urgent need for the strengthening and democratizing of the UN system, including the campaign for UNPA, and building of democratic regional institutions
- pursues the following strategic priorities with specific political initiatives through the mobilization of latent energies existing in the WFM, notably at national level,
 - 1. Nuclear proliferation and disarmament;
 - 2. Climate change and sustainable development;
 - 3. Financial and economic global crisis and reform of the Bretton Woods Institutions;
- develops a program for training and education of young people, through the organization of annual seminars in the great regions of the world, such as Ventotene;

And in order to achieve these goals, the WFM and its local MOs and AOs will:

- direct their joint efforts to the creation of regional offices and the networks devoted to them, starting by Latin America, Africa and South-Asia, and the International Secretariat will prepare a specific program on the Democratization of the International and Global Order and develop a fundraising campaign related to it.
