### Background

The United Nations will hold a **Summit for the Future**, September 22-23, 2024 in order to advance 'Multilateral Solutions for a Better Tomorrow.' UN Member States are already preparing a **Declaration for Future Generations** to be adopted prior to the Summit and a **Pact for the Future** to be adopted at the Summit.

**Civil society** is playing an active role in the UN Summit preparations, including through the **2024 UN Civil Society Conference** taking place from May 9-10, 2024.
